MEMBERSHIP DUES AND COMPETENCY BASED COMPETITIVE EVENT NUMBERS

State DECA dues of \$7.00 per member and International DECA dues of \$8.00 per member, for a total of \$15.00, must be **RECEIVED** in the International DECA office by October 15, 2010. Make your dues check payable to DECA and send to:

International DECA may assess a late fee of \$5.00 per member after October 15, 2010. **ROSTERS ARE ONLY PROCESSED WHEN PAYMENT IN FULL IS RECEIVED BY INTERNATIONAL DECA.** This does not include purchase orders.

Each Colorado DECA chapter must submit their **CHAPTER MEMBERSHIP AND PARTICIPATING EVENT REPORT** form (page 86 of the Colorado DECA Local Chapter Advisor's Handbook 2010-2011) to their respective DECA Advisory Committee member by October 15, 2010. Your report and paid DECA membership must match. If these numbers are not accurate and/or are not received by this date, your

membership roster will be divided equally among the competency-based participating events or entered as "0" by the Advisory Committee member. If zeros are assigned, your chapter will be ineligible for district conference participation. The Advisory Committee member **MUST** have the district summary sheet submitted to Bryan Whiting, Glenwood Springs High School (bryanwhiting@rfsd.k12.co.us) and the state office by October 18, 2010. Numbers may be submitted to the state office by e-mail, Everett.vaughan@cccs.edu or by fax at 720-904-2545.

Your paid competency-based event numbers MUST match your online PAID membership as of October 15, 2010 for District Conference Participation.

ONLINE MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION

All Colorado DECA chapters will register their membership with the International DECA "Online Membership Registration System". <http://www.deca.org/hs/membershipprocesing.html> As the local DECA chapter advisor, you will have 24 hour access to your membership activities. Please read the online instructions completely before starting the Online Membership Registration. Advisors must adequately plan their time lines in order to allow for **FULL PAYMENT to be RECEIVED AND PROCESSED** by International DECA. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS** to the Colorado deadline of October 15, 2010.

At 4:30 pm Denver time, October 15, 2010, Colorado DECA will print a copy of each chapter's PAID MEMBERSHIP ROSTER. These rosters will be the official rosters used for district conference participation. The roster will be made available to the DECA Advisory Committee member for your district. In addition, The rosters will be loaded onto the District Conference database. **ONLY** those students listed on the October 15, 2010 roster will be allowed to compete at the district conference and qualify for state competition in individual and series events. Additional memberships will be accepted until January 14, 2011 for members wishing to participate in written events only at state or in ICDC activities. The January deadline corresponds with the State Leadership Conference deadline.

NOTE: The spelling of names is extremely important. The spelling you register your members with online will be the spelling used for the entire year for state related activities.

CONFERENCE REGISTRATIONS

Colorado DECA will strictly enforce the time lines printed on each call to conference. Registration per participant is increased by \$10.00 when submitted late and is subject to another \$10.00 per participant fee increase when payment is late. These fees are not negotiable. Purchase orders may not be substituted for payment.

A \$5.00 fee is assessed for EACH change made to the original conference registration. A cover letter and amended registration highlighting each change must be submitted to the State Advisor.

The previous registration information will then be replaced by the amended registration. Verbal changes are not accepted; all changes must be in writing.

Each chapter must have their state DECA account at a \$0 (zero) balance within 35 days after the last DECA event or they will be ineligible for participation in further DECA activities until the balance is zero. In addition, those not complying will be assessed an additional unpaid late fee stated in the Colorado DECA Local Chapter Advisors Handbook 2010-2011. The late fee must also be paid prior to further participation. Note: Adopted September, 1990, Amended 9/97, Amended 5/99, Amended 8/01 by the DECA State Advisory Committee.

If two or more schools join together for any reason, one advisor must be designated as the lead advisor and be responsible for all paperwork and financial responsibilities. Only ONE form and payment will be accepted by Colorado DECA. The State Office will only accept a check from one school. The partnering school(s) must pay the lead advisors school for their portion of the amount due.

There will be NO refunds given for activities once the registration has been received. Replacements, where allowed, are subject to the \$5.00 late fee. The only exception will be for students placed by Colorado DECA at the International Conference.

STATE JUDGES

It is important once again to begin recruiting judges for state as soon as possible. We will be using approximately 400 judges again at our state conference. If you have a new person who is willing to judge at the 2011 state leadership conference, please provide them with the attached judge's letter and have them register at our website, www.decajudge.org Also, please contact Chuck Blood, chuckblood@aol.com and let him know their name(s) so he can follow up. The sooner we can get our judges secured, the better. Chuck will periodically be sending out information to everyone concerning judges for state conference.

MEDICAL FORMS

The STUDENT AUTHORIZATION-MEDICAL RELEASE-PARENTAL CONSENT FORM should be completed and submitted to you, the local chapter advisor. You should keep this form in your possession for all DECA activities. DO NOT submit to the district or state advisor.

*The ADULT AUTHORIZATION-MEDICAL RELEASE form should be completed by each adult attending a Colorado DECA sponsored activity. A copy **MUST** be provided to Colorado DECA prior to attendance at the sponsored event. The forms are provided below and also found in the Colorado Local Chapter Advisor Handbook for 2010-1011. A separate form is required for each student and adult attending state authorized activities.*

WRLC (WESTERN REGIONAL LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE)

Colorado DECA members will have the opportunity to attend the "Power Trip" conference this year in Washington D.C. November 12-14. The Western Region along with the North Atlantic and Southern DECA Regions have combined this year to create the 2011 Super Conference. Brennan Boehne, Western Region Vice President from Colorado is encouraging as many DECA members as possible to attend this exciting conference. SLC (STATE LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE)

The 2011 SLC will be held February 27 – March 1 at the Broadmoor Hotel in Colorado Springs. This will be our 46th SLC held at the Broadmoor Hotel. Colorado DECA has held the SLC at the Broadmoor every year, except two, since 1964. We have built a great relationship with the Broadmoor and will continue to do so for future years. We will be using 665 rooms at the Broadmoor and 140 rooms at the Cheyenne Mountain Resort. More information will be sent out as we get closer to the time of state registration. An individual registration fee of \$110.00 has been established for the conference. The RECEIVED registration deadline will be January 14, 2011 at 4:30pm. The scholarship application deadline for the Colorado DECA (Harry Applegate scholarship form), Marketing/DECA memorial scholarship and Student of the year (Harry Applegate scholarship form) will be due January 28, 2011. If you or your chapter

would like to make a contribution to any or all of these scholarship funds, please send a check to Colorado DECA and designate which scholarship you wish your funds to go toward.

ICDC (INTERNATIONAL CAREER DEVELOPMENT CONFERENCE)

This year Colorado DECA members who qualify for the International conference will have the opportunity to travel to sunny Orlando, Florida for ICDC on April 30-May 3, 2011. Colorado will be in the second tier group (slots 12-22 of 55 possible slots) in hotel selection. The conference hotels will be viewed during the SAM (State Association Management) conference August 11-14, 2010. Once I have viewed the hotels I will be able to submit our three top hotel choices to International DECA. The size of our delegation is not as big of an issue as it was in Louisville, Kentucky so we should have a wide choice of hotels to choose from this year. This year we should qualify for approximately 470 ICDC slots.

DECA State Judge Candidate,

*You have been recommended to serve as a judge for the DECA State Leadership Conference, which will be held on **February 27-March 1, 2011**, at the Broadmoor Hotel in Colorado Springs. There will be over 2600 Colorado DECA student participants and your help would be greatly appreciated. **We will need judges on February 28 and/or March 1.** The judging experience will be similar to the local, district or state conferences that you may have judged previously.*

*Many of you will probably elect to judge only on Monday, February 28. However, we will need a number of judges to evaluate students in the finals on Tuesday morning. Also, we would like to encourage you to consider **judging written events** which involves the evaluation of written projects prior to the conference along with the evaluation of **both** the initial competition on Monday and the finals on Tuesday morning. If needed, Colorado DECA will pay for your lodging on Monday evening (written event judge's only). All competitions should conclude by approximately noon on Tuesday.*

*This year we will be using the Internet to register our new judges and to complete a brief profile sheet. Consequently, if you have not judged at the DECA State Leadership conference before, we are asking each of you to go to www.decajudge.org when registering for judging at our State DECA conference. As always, your help and support is paramount to the success of this conference. If you volunteer to judge, you should block out the dates with the understanding that **you will be judging** at the DECA State Conference. Please feel free to invite any of your associates, friends, or neighbors to judge as well. Please ensure that they register on-line to confirm their registration.*

If you are planning on arriving in Colorado Springs prior to the start of the conference and you are in need of hotel accommodations, I have listed local hotel information below. The Broadmoor Hotel will be made available to student delegates, chaperones, and advisors first. I would suggest that you check with the Cheyenne Mountain Conference Resort first, as they are the closest hotel to the Broadmoor and serve as the alternate site for judges and guests. Free bus transportation to and from The Cheyenne Mountain Resort and the Broadmoor will be provided by Colorado DECA for all judges on the days of competition.
